Audi South is the home of Audi's largest retail and aftersales service centre in Ireland.

The custom-built, multi-storey terminal, designed by Dublin-based EMD Architects, is located on Bracken Road, Sandyford, and replaced the existing Audi centre on the 20,000 square-metre site.

Internally, the ground floor showroom consists of a customer reception area, service reception, new car display and new car handover bays. The first floor showroom also includes Audi Sport display, and digital customer lounges.



Full Mechanical Services Package was installed including LPHW Heating System, Underfloor Heating System, Air Conditioning System, Water, Waste, Ventilation and BMS Controls

The new Audi Centre showroom is Ireland's greenest building of its type– the building envelope has been designed to include several low energy solutions and a wide range of enhanced service systems aimed at reducing energy consumption.
