The National Indoor Arena Covered Pitches are world-class training facilities comprising of a full-sized covered soccer pitch and a half size covered rugby pitch and multiple changing rooms.

The facility officially opened in June 2019 by An Taoiseach Leo Varadkar as part of Project Ireland 2040, will be used by a host of international, club and county teams and provides permanent indoor facilities for Gaelic games, Soccer and Rugby including:

- Full-size indoor synthetic soccer pitch to GAA standards for Synthetic Pitches with changing rooms, office space, storage
- Indoor synthetic rugby pitch to IRFU standards, with changing rooms, office space, storage
- Elite Fitness and Conditioning Centre

This covered facility will allow the teams to train all year round, regardless of weather conditions, in a consistent world class environment, for use by the respective men’s and women’s national squads.
